Chester's history stretches over 2,000 years and all the dramatic events that shaped the destiny of Britain are etched immortally into the very fabric of its heritage. Two miles of city walls, the largest Roman amphitheater in Britain and the world-famous medieval "rows" are all found in Chester

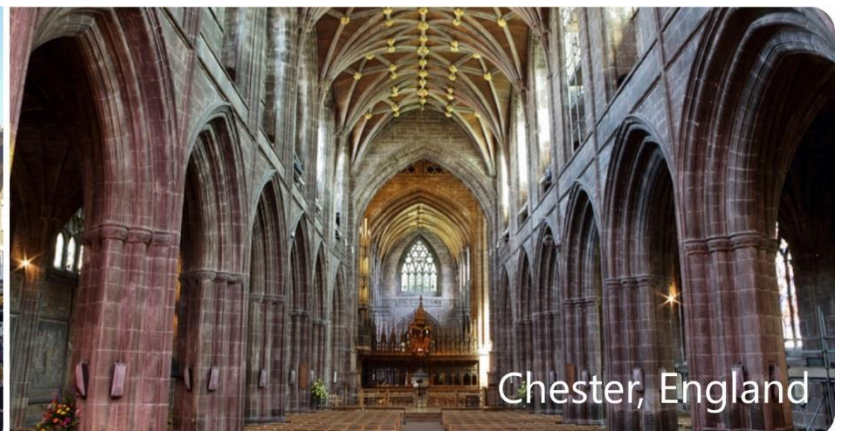
evening **Concert** (in Chester Cathedral?)
